



ClubSwan 42 Rule Changes - Scarlino Swan One Design 2019

The current updates and re-formatting of the ClubSwan 42 Class Rules are in the final stages of editing and checking. Following the agreement of the Class at the AGM in 2019 the following will be permitted for the Scarlino Event.

Group 3 Limitation

The crew is limited to 3 x Group 3 Sailors

Sail Inventory

A staysail with an area and specification as detailed in Class Rule 26.8 is permitted.

26.8.3 Staysail

26.8.1 The following are permitted: Stitching, glues, tapes, bolt ropes, corner eyes, Cunningham eye or pulley, batten pocket patches, batten pocket elastic, batten pocket end caps, leech line with cleat, windows, tell tales, sail shape indicator stripes, roller furler and high modulus luff line.

26.8.2 Staysail dimensions shall not exceed:

- a. Luff Length (LL): 17.75 m
- b. Luff Perpendicular (LP): 4.0 m
- c. Half Width (HHW): 2.0 m
- d. Maximum Staysail Head Width: 100 mm – maximum as measured from an extension of the luff tape to the back of the genoa head.

Bobstay

A bobstay is permitted, the material is optional however solid bobstays are not permitted and the bobstay must not prevent the retraction of the bowsprit.
