1 - Rules

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and the rules of each one-design class.

1.2. Life jackets must be worn at sea when the Race Committee displays the IC Code Flag 'Y'. Infringement of this rule may lead to disqualification.

2 - Eligible Classes

2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the classes listed in 2.2.

2.2. Accepted classes: **ClubSwan 50' + Swan 45' + ClubSwan 42'**

2.3. A minimum of 5 boats per class is required.

Accepted classes will be published on the Yacht Club de Monaco's website (www.yacht-club-monaco.mc).

3 - Entries

3.1. The World Sailing Eligibility Code, World Sailing Regulation 19 shall apply. Crew list and World Sailing Sailors ID's for all crew, as well as declarations of alternate, substitute and relief helmsmen shall be submitted by email to the Class Manager no later than Tuesday, 26 March 2019:

6 - Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be given to the competitors following registration confirmation by the Race Office.

7 - Race Course

The course to be sailed will be a course laid in Monaco's bay.

8 - Scoring

8.1. A maximum of 3 races may be held on any one race day.

8.2. Separate results for each class will conform to the World Sailing's Low Point System in the RRS's Appendix A.

8.3. One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.4. Nine races are scheduled. There will be no discard

9 - Penalty

Rule 44.1 of the RRS is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

10 - Advertising

10.1. Advertising must conform to World Sailing regulation 20.4.

10.2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

11 - Prize giving Ceremony

Prize-giving ceremony will be held at the Yacht Club de Monaco on Saturday 13th April 2019 at 5.30pm. At least one crew member is expected to attend the ceremony.

12 - Jury

Decisions of the International Jury are final.

The classification Protest time limit will be at 10.00 on Wednesday 10th April

13 - Media Rights

All competitors give absolute right and permission to the organizers and event sponsors to use, publish, broadcast or otherwise distribute for promotional, advertising or any other purpose, any images and sound recorded during the event of persons and boats free of charge.

All participants agree to waive their copyright claims to photographs taken of them during the event, and their right to have any recourse against the organizers for the use made of these photographs.

14 - Moorings & Parking

14.1. The Yacht Club de Monaco will provide a berth per registered boat, subject to availability as follows:

From 12 noon Monday 8th April 2019 to 11am Sunday 14 April 2019.

14.2. Additional parking space for your car/van will be organized by the Yacht Club de Monaco. The cost will not exceed €10 per day.

The Yacht Club de Monaco will not be held responsible if your vehicle is parked illegally and fined or towed away.

17 - Getting to Monaco

17.1. By train

Monaco-Monte-Carlo Railway Station.

Within the Station, follow the signs for 'Sainte Dévote – Port'.

17.2. By car

On the A8 motorway from Nice: exit N° 56 Monaco.

On the A8 motorway from Menton: exit N° 58 Roquebrune.

On main roads, follow signs for 'Monaco - Le Port'.

17.4. From Nice Côte d'Azur International Airport

- By bus: shuttle between the airport and Monaco.

Operated by RCA from terminals 1 and 2. Departures are every 30'

- By taxi: taxi ranks are outside terminals 1 and 2.

- By helicopter: check-in desks in the arrival zones in terminals 1 and 2 at Nice Côte d'Azur International Airport. Departures every 20 minutes, from Nice airport and Monaco heliport. The flight takes approximately 6 minutes and shuttle buses are available from and to the heliport.
