## **Measurement Checks 2024**

Further to discussion during recent Owners Meeting, on December 4<sup>th</sup>, the following measurement checks are intended for the 2024 CS36 Nations League Season.

Prior to a teams first event of the 2024 season the following shall be checked:

- Boat weight,
- Foil and keel position,
- Bulb, Keel Fin & Foil shape with templates.

*Team are responsible for contacting the Class to arrange the measurement session. To minimise costs, the Class will support teams to arrange joint sessions.*

Weighing sessions will additionally be planned at each CS36 Nations League Event where venue logistics permit to meet the fleet requirements and to minimise costs.

Additionally, during the season spot checks may be carried out on the following (additional items may be checked)

- Keel fin, bulb & foil template checks,
- Keel & foil position checks,
- Core-drill check on bulb pocket contents.

The boat weight in measurement condition is currently set at 2720kg. Following a review of the boat's weight in addition to the adjustment for the bulb modification the class minimum weight is to be increased by 15kg.

This will make the boat weight in Class Rule C.6.2 - 2525kg\*

\* *The above weight is based on a final machined bulb weight of 700kg.*
